

STUDENT APPLICATION FOR INTERNET ACCESS

**through sites located within the
London District Catholic School Board**

This is an application for Internet Access through your school network(s). Such access is a privilege, and will be granted only to students who agree to follow the guidelines established by the London District Catholic School Board. Any student who fails to follow the terms and conditions will face penalties, ranging from denial of access for a limited time, to permanent denial of Internet access, or to criminal action for illegal activity. Please read the following set of terms and conditions for Internet Access carefully.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS FOR INTERNET ACCESS

Any student using Board Internet access services will do so in a manner which reflects our Catholic Mission Statement and must:

1. receive permission from their teacher before accessing the Internet
2. only download or upload files with teacher permission and supervision
3. back out of any site which is transmitting unacceptable information or graphics, and immediately report the accidental visit to the teacher
4. use proper, socially acceptable communication - no profanity, sexual, racial, religious or ethnic slurs

Students will not:

1. send, display or store any offensive pictures or messages
2. use obscene language, or language reflecting racial, ethnic or religious prejudice
3. wilfully damage computers, computer systems, computer networks, or computer peripherals attached to school computers
4. violate copyright laws
5. use other's userids, passwords or e-mail addresses
6. employ Board provided Internet access for commercial purposes
7. violate security systems which have been put into place to protect computers, file servers, networks and users, both within and outside the board
8. provide personal information about themselves or others through the Internet (name, phone number, address, picture etc.)
9. use Internet access in any ways which waste finite resources. This includes storage space (on network or computer drives), internet bandwidth, printer resources, diskettes, etc.
10. use email for non-educational purposes

The school and the board have the authority to check the storage areas for any user to ensure compliance with the terms and conditions of the Student Application for Internet Access.

Any students identified as a security risk using computer systems may be denied Board Internet access.
