

Sabrina's Law

The Legislative Assembly of Ontario passed Bill 3, *Sabrina's Law*, which requires all school boards to develop and maintain a policy on anaphylaxis. This includes strategies to reduce the risk of a reaction as well as informing staff, students and visitors of the risks of anaphylaxis. Also included in this Bill is continued training of all staff members to recognize the risks and know what to do in a timely manner.
