Criminal Reference Checks

In order to volunteer in a school, you must have a Criminal Reference check which is done by the London Police Department. . In order to make the process easier for parents, the school will be doing a group collection tomorrow from 8:30—9:30 and from 3:30—6:00. **This is for parents who do not have a police check on file at the school.** You must provide proof of age and address for the Principal to verify be-

fore signing off on the application. These applications will then be taken to the Police Station by the Principal. Once completed, the Police will call the school and the Principal will pick them up and keep them on file. The original must be kept at the school. There is a \$10.00 cost for this and please bring cash as it takes a week or longer for the police to process a cheque. Thank you for your support of this volunteer policy.
